GIVE DIRECTION TO YOUR LIFE – JOIN THE INDIAN NAVY

1. Applications are invited from **unmarried Men and Women candidates** for Short Service Commission in Air Traffic Control Cadre of Executive Branch, of the Indian Navy for Course commencing **Jan 2011** at Indian Naval Academy (INA) Ezhimala, Kerala. Candidates to fulfil condition of nationality as laid down by the Government of India.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- Age.** 19 ½ to 25 years born between 02 Jan 1986 and 01 Jul 1991 both dates inclusive.
- Educational Qualifications.**
 - B Sc in Physics, Mathematics or Electronics with minimum 60% marks or
 - M Sc in Physics, Mathematics or Electronics with minimum 55% marks**Note:** Candidates who have not completed their Degree (i.e appearing candidates) need not apply.
- Physical Standards**
 - Height and Weight.** Minimum height - Male- 157 cms, Female -152 cms with correlated weight.
 - Eye Sight.** The minimum acceptable vision standard for distant vision 6/6, 6/9 correctable to 6/6, 6/6 with glasses and should not be colour/night blind.

SHORT SERVICE COMMISSION

5. Short Service Commission is granted for a term of 10 years, extendable to 14 years, subject to service requirement and performance/willingness of the candidate. On completion of these tenures, officers are entitled for gratuity under the extant rules. Disciplined life, leadership qualities and professional skills imbibed during the service would stand as added advantages in acquiring second career post exit from the Navy.

HOW TO APPLY

6. (a) Application Forms in accordance with the prescribed format and complete in all respects with superscription on the envelope "**APPLICATION FOR SSC (ATC) JAN 2011 COURSE Qualification..... Percentage.....%**" are to be sent to the address given below by **06 Aug 10**. Applications sent by Speed Post/Registered Post/Courier will not be accepted.

- Application must be sent in the format given in the advertisement, otherwise it will be rejected.
- Application must be accompanied by **attested copies** of : - (i) 10th Standard Certificate for verification of date of birth and other educational certificates. (ii) Marks statement of all semesters/years.
- Application and requisite enclosures must be properly tagged/stitched by thread only. Integrated Headquarters, Ministry of Defence (Navy) (IHQ-MoD (Navy)) will not be responsible for loss of enclosures, if sent loose.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- (a) The candidates will be issued call up for Services Selection Board (SSB) based on their performance in Degree Course. If a candidate possesses higher qualification with better percentage, his/her higher qualification will be considered for cut off. Integrated Headquarters, Ministry of Defence (Navy) reserves the right to shortlist applications and to fix cut off percentage. No communication will be entertained on this account. SSB interviews for short listed candidates will be scheduled at Bangalore /Bhopal/ Coimbatore during Aug to Nov 2010.
- Stage I test consisting of Intelligence test, Picture Perception and Discussion test will be conducted on the second day of arrival at SSB. Candidate who fail to qualify in Stage I will be routed back on the same day. Stage II tests comprising of Psychological testing, Group testing and Interview will last for 04 days. Successful candidates will thereafter undergo Medical Examination (approx duration 03-05 days).
- Candidates recommended by the SSBs and declared medically fit, will be appointed for training in order of All India Merit depending on the number of vacancies.
- Change of SSB venue for interview is not permissible.
- Any correspondence regarding change of SSB dates be addressed to the President of the concerned SSB on receipt of call up letter and copy endorsed to Directorate of Manpower Planning & Recruitment (OI & R), Room No. 204, 'C' Wing, Sena Bhawan, IHQ-MoD(N), New Delhi-110011. Award of fresh dates for SSB would be subject to availability.
- No compensation will be paid in respect of injury sustained as a result of tests.
- Return 2nd Class Sleeper rail fare is admissible for the SSB interview, if appearing for the first time for the entry.

8. TRAINING

Candidates will be inducted as officers in the rank of Sub Lieutenant in Jan 2011 and undergo Naval Orientation Course at the Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala followed by professional training at various Naval Training Establishments/Units/Ships. Full Pay and allowances are admissible to the Officers whilst undergoing training.

9. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Selected Candidates will be on a probation for 02 yrs from the date of reporting to the Indian Naval Academy or the date of commencement of training whichever is later. Any candidate found married or who marries while undergoing training will be discharged. He/She shall be liable to refund full pay & allowances drawn by him/her and any other expenditure incurred on him/her by the Govt. On completion of training, ATC officers can be transferred anywhere for ATC duties.

10. DUTIES OF AN AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL OFFICER

The Indian Navy operates various types of modern aircraft from shore based airfields as well as from ships. Air Traffic Control Officers in the Indian Navy control naval fighter aircraft, maritime reconnaissance aircraft and multi role helicopters both ashore and afloat.
