GIVE DIRECTION TO YOUR LIFE - JOIN THE INDIAN NAVY

- Applications are invited from **unmarried Male and Female candidates** for grant of Short Service Commission (SSC) in the Logistics Cadre of Executive Branch of the Indian Navy for Course commencing **Jul 2010** at Indian Naval Academy (INA) Ezhimala, Kerala. Candidates to fulfil condition of nationality as laid down by the Government of India.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- Age:** 19½ to 25 years (i.e. born between **02 Jul 1985** and **01 Jan 1991**; both dates inclusive).
- Educational Qualification:** A First Class Degree with minimum 60% aggregate marks from a recognised University in any of the following:
 - B COM (b) BA (Economics) (c) MBA (d) BBA (e) BBM (f) MCA (g) BCA (h) BSc(IT)
 - B.Tech/BE (any discipline including civil engineering) (k) B.Architecture (l) Graduate Degree with Post Graduate Diploma / Degree in Materials Management (m) ICWA (n) Chartered Accountancy.

Catering. Degree in Hotel/Hospitality Management

Note: Candidates who have not completed their Degree (i.e. appearing candidates) need not apply.

PHYSICAL STANDARDS

- Height and Weight.** Minimum height Male-157 & Female-152 cms with correlated weight.
- Eye Sight.** 6/36, 6/36 correctable to 6/6, 6/12 with glasses and should not be colour/night blind.

SHORT SERVICE COMMISSION

- Short Service Commission is granted for a period of 10 years, extendable to 14 years subject to service requirement and performance/willingness of the candidate. On completion of these tenures, officers are released with gratuity as admissible under the rules.

HOW TO APPLY

- If you meet the above requirements, apply on plain A4 size paper (typed or handwritten) in the prescribed format duly completed in all respects with superscription on the envelope "SSC- LOGISTICS CADRE – JUL 2010 COURSE, Educational QualificationAggregate Percentage.....%" are to be sent by **12 Dec 2009** to the address given below:-

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Candidates will be issued call up for Service Selection Board (SSB) interviews based on their performance in educational qualification. If a candidate possesses higher qualification with better percentage, his higher qualification will be considered for cut off. Integrated Headquarters, Ministry of Defence (Navy) (IHQ-MoD (Navy)) reserves the right to short-list applications and to fix cut off percentage without assigning any reason. No communication will be entertained on this account
 - SSB interviews for short-listed candidates will be scheduled during Jan to Jun 2010 at Bangalore, Bhopal or Coimbatore.
 - The SSB interview is conducted over five days in two stages. Stage-I includes intelligence Test, Picture Perception test and Group discussion and is conducted on the first day. Stage-II includes Psychological Tests, Group Task and personal interview conducted over the balance four days. Candidates failing to qualify a particular stage would be sent back the same day. Successful candidates would then have to clear a special medical examination at the same venue (approx duration 3-5 days).
 - Candidates recommended by the SSBs and declared medically fit will be appointed for training in order of all India Merit depending on the number of vacancies.
 - Change of SSB centre for interview is not permissible under any circumstances.
 - Candidates who wish to change their SSB dates, must apply to the President of the SSB.
 - No compensation will be paid in respect of any injury sustained during the selection process.
 - Candidates appearing for SSB interview for the first time for this entry would be eligible free rail sleeper class return fare.

TRAINING

- The training is scheduled to commence in July 2010
- Candidates will be inducted as officers in the rank of Sub Lieutenant and undergo Naval Orientation Course at the Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala, followed by professional training at various Naval Training Establishments/Units/Ships. Full pay and allowances are admissible to officers whilst under training. They will be on probation for a period of two years, during which they are liable to be discharged if their performance is unsatisfactory.
- Only unmarried candidates are eligible to undergo training. Any candidate who is found to be married or marries while under training will be discharged. He shall be liable to refund full pay & allowances drawn by him and the expenditure incurred on him by the Government.

DUTIES

- Duties of the Logistics officer and Catering officer are as follows: -

(a) **Logistics Officer.** As a Logistics Officer you will be dealing with the Logistics aspects of Men & Material for the Warships. In no other career does an Officer gets exposed to such a wide spectrum of opportunities to keep abreast of modern and latest development in the field of management & finance.

(b) **Catering Officer.** Two vacancies will be reserved for graduates in Hotel/Hospitality Management, who would be employed in the Navy **ONLY** for jobs directly related to their specialization e.g. select Naval Messes (ashore and onboard ships), training, and other jobs concerning food/ beverages, rations, and housekeeping, as deemed appropriate.

THE NAVY OFFERS YOU

- On successful completion of training you will be commissioned as Sub Lieutenant. The benefits of the life as an officer in the Navy are enumerated in succeeding paragraphs.
- Pay Scale & Promotions.** The promotion from Sub Lieutenant to Commander is on time scale basis and thereafter on selection basis subject to fulfilment of requisite service condition. The Pay Scale and promotion criteria is as follows:-

- Privileges.** Free Medical Facilities for Self & dependents, Canteen Facilities, Entitled Ration, Mess/Club/Sports Facilities, Furnished Govt. Accommodation, Car/Housing Loan at subsidised rate.

- Group Insurance & Gratuity.** Insurance cover of Rs. 30 lakhs (on contribution) and Gratuity will be granted to the officer as per the latest rules in vogue.

- Leave Entitlements.** On Commission, officers are entitled to 60 days annual and 20 days casual leave every year (subject to service exigencies). They are also entitled for 40% rail concession to any place and free travel (as per extant rules) for self and family. Leave during training period will be as per the Training Policy in vogue.

- Sports & Adventure.** The Navy provides facilities to pursue any sport of your liking. In addition, one can learn and participate in adventure sports, such as river rafting, mountaineering, hot air ballooning, hang gliding, wind surfing etc.

- Physical fitness.** In Naval Academy curriculum, a lot of emphasis is laid on physical fitness. You are therefore, advised to build up yourself by physical training, sports, running, swimming, etc. so that you meet the training goals successfully.
